















- Disabled Veterans' Outreach Program Specialist (DVOP) provide eligible persons with significant barriers to employment with intensive services
- What We Do
   Depare Provide Printer (P3)

   • Enforcement of Vietnam Era Veterans' Readjustment Assistance Act (VEVRA)
   • Orbhibits Federal contractors from discriminating against protected veterans and requires equal employment opportunity and affirmative action for protected veterans

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   • Takes complaints involving hostile work environments for veterans

   • Where necessary, assures contractors' requirement to develop linkages and list job openings with the Employment Service.

   • Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act (USERRA)

   • VETS enforces veterans re-employment rights to return to civilian employment once tour of duty concludes









- Funding is used to staff Veteran Representatives that work directly with veterans
- In Alaska, Veteran Representatives have been placed in areas with the highest veteran concentration
